

Myocarditis

Infectious myocarditis:

Viruses (50% of the cases)	Coxsackie B (frequent and dangerous!), influenza, parainfluenza-, adeno, mumps, echo viruses, mycoplasma; antibody detection or titer increase;
Bacteria	Staphylococci, enterococci, A streptococci, borrelia, rarer bacterial causes: diphtheria, typhoid fever, tuberculosis, lues; microorganism detection from blood cultures or antibody detection;
Fungi	Candida albicans cultural detection, antigen and antibody detection. in immune deficiency;
Protozoa	Toxoplasmosis (antibody detection); Trypanosoma cruzi (Chagas disorder, antibody detection, microorganism detection in blood smear); malaria (microorganism detection in blood smear, antibody detection);
Parasites	Trichinae, echinococcus: antibody detection;
