

Paroxetine

General:

Paroxetine is a selective serotonin reuptake inhibitor antidepressant. Paroxetine is used to treat major depression, obsessive-compulsive disorder, post-traumatic stress disorder, panic disorder, generalized anxiety disorder, social phobia/social anxiety disorder and premenstrual dysphoric disorder. Co-administration with a monoamine oxidase inhibitor may result in increased serotonin concentrations in the synapses leading to the serotonin syndrome with muscle rigidity and myoclonus. The drug has a slight sedative action, no antimuscarinic properties, no effect on norepinephrine or dopamine turnover.
