

Anti factor 8

General:

Inhibitor antibodies of blood coagulation factor VIII (FVIII) impair FVIII replacement therapy, constituting a serious complication in hemophilic patients. anti-FVIII antibodies may also develop in a variety of disease-associated autoimmunities.

Material: 1 ml citrate plasma, **frozen**

TAT: 7-10 days*

Method: coagulation
