

# Enteritis bacteriological viral detection in stool<sup>^</sup>

## see Diarrhea

Indication: Differential diagnosis of enteritis causing bacteria: salmonellae, shigellae, E.coli, e.g. (e.g. EHEC), Aeromonas hydrophilia, Plesiomonas shigelloides, Yersinia enterocolitica, campylobacter, and Clostridium difficile (pseudomembraneous colitis, esp. after clindamycin therapy), rota virus, adeno virus, astro virus, norwalk virus.

Material: Stool

TAT: 7-10 days\*

Method: culture/latex agglutination and PCR
