

Hair loss

Endocrine	Hyperthyroidism, hypothyroidism, hypopituitarism, parathyroidism, virilism or drug related (anticonception with a strong progesterone component), postmenopausal as a result of a relative androgen surplus
Toxic	Thallium
Drug related	Cytostatics, anticoagulants, thyreostatics, substances with effect on lipid metabolism, antiepileptics, antifungal drugs, antimalarial drugs
Infectious	Influenza, typhoid fever, lues, tuberculosis
Others	Collagenosis (scleroderma, lupus erythematodes), iron deficiency (hypermenorrhea), protein deficiency diet (Kwashiorkor), neoplasia, cirrhosis, vitamin deficiency (vitamin A, D, E and F, folic acid, B12), magnesium deficiency, zinc deficiency, post-operative, mechanical, synthesis defect in hair growth (e.g. at aminoaciduria, homocystinuria, orotaciduria, phenylketonuria)
